Fabric 1 - Solid Pink

Fabric 2 - Red Print

Fabric 3 - Solid Red

Skill Level BEGINNER

Finished Size: 12" x 12"

Cutting Instructions:

Fabric 1, Background

... 16 squares 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" (Piece 1A)

... 4 squares 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (Piece 1B)

... 4 strips 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" (Piece 1C)

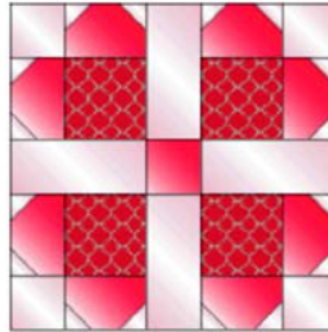
Fabric 2, Red Print

... 4 squares 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" (Piece 2D)

Fabric 3, Red

... 1 square 2 1/2" x 2 1/2" (Piece 3B)

... 8 rectangles 2 1/2" x 3 1/2" (Piece 3E)

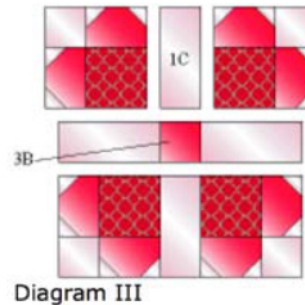


Piecing the Block:

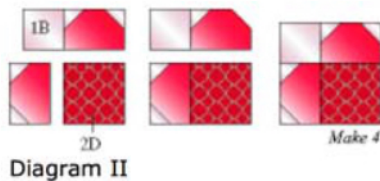
Step 1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of Piece 1A squares. Align squares with Piece 3E rectangle, top corners, right sides together (**Diagram I**). Sew on previously drawn line. Cut away excess fabric leaving 1/4" seam allowance to make pieced rectangles. Make 8 total.



Step 3. Referring to **Diagram III**, sew pieced squares, 4 background strips, and red 2 1/2" square together to make Pieced Hearts Block.



Step 2. Referring to **Diagram II**, layout pieced-rectangles, Piece 1B and Piece 2D to form corner unit. Sew together to make pieced square. Make 4 total.



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
